Minimum Qualifications:

Paramedic Certification

- Valid certification card issued by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians at the Paramedic level.
- OR**
- Valid EMS certification card issued by the Iowa Department of Public Health, Bureau of EMS at the EMT Paramedic or Paramedic Specialist level.

Firefighter I Certification

- Fire Fighter I certification document issued by the Iowa Fire Service Training Bureau.
- OR**
- Any IFSAC (International Fire Service Accreditation Congress) approved training program.

CPR Certification

- Current AHA, Healthcare Provider, Basic Life Support certification card.
- OR**
- Current ARC, Professional Rescuer Certification card.

Additional Documentation

- Valid driver's license issued by a state licensing agency.
- Paramedic specific – Current American Heart Association, Advanced Life Support certification card.

Physical fitness and written exams are required for all positions. Must be at least 18 years old to apply. The written examination will be held on Tuesday, April 6th at 6:00 p.m. and the physical ability evaluation will be held on Saturday, April 10th. Informational packets regarding the testing will be mailed to qualified applicants.

Successful completion of post-offer criminal background screening, drug test, and medical physical required. Excellent wage and benefit package. Starting annual salary Paramedic is \$37,857.
